Title of Project/Event Ethnicity Workshop: Tracing Chicanismo—History, Community, and Impact

Date(s) of Project April 14, 2007

Amount Awarded \$2,500

1. Original Goals and objectives--to attract approximately 40 student and faculty participants to explore the Chicano movement with a set of distinguished scholars and student leaders who would serve as panelists, moderators, and facilitators. The workshop was to expose students and faculty in a condensed and engaging manner to key ideas and personal experiences emanating from the Chicano movement. Workshop participants were asked to share experiences, debate ideas, and plan future activities through lecture/presentation, panel discussion, and small group breakout sessions.
2. Any changes made in goals/objectives to date—we ended up not being able to confirm the national figures from the Chicano Movement due to time and budgetary constraints. Some of these figures are now demanding large honoraria and we were not able to meet their expectations. We substituted their participation with that of local Chicanos who played key roles in the Movement.
3. Activities underway and/or completed to date. All of the planning and preparations for the workshop have been completed. This included reserving rooms, ordering food, creating and printing a program. The workshop took place about 10 days ago and was successful in accomplishing the technical aspects of the grant. A focus group with 12 participants in the workshop was conducted yesterday (April 23). The findings gathered in that session will be reported in the final grant report document.

4. Any snags or unanticipated delays encountered—Yes. We were unable to host the workshop in mid-March as anticipated. We postponed the date until mid-April, but were able to attract presenters, students, and faculty.
5. Approved budget--\$2,500.
