Resolution

Whereas, the Senior Student Affairs Officers of the Associated Colleges of the South advocate for the most distinguished and excellent standards embodied by key leaders of our profession; and,

Whereas, superior student affairs standards in leadership, management, and achievement, when coupled with longevity in service, are partially recognized by the Leonard Goldberg Citation; and,

Whereas, the Leonard Goldberg Citation was created in 2004-2005 to acknowledge the notable and enduring contributions of student personnel leaders across the southeastern United States as well as across the nation; and,

Whereas, the Leonard Goldberg Citation has been elevated in prominence by the previous selections of such student affairs luminaries as Leonard Goldberg, Harry Shucker, Frances Lucas, Tom Shandley & Patty Perrillo, and Harold Holmes; and,

Whereas, **Ms. Dudley Long** is a professional who role models all of the principles embedded in the Goldberg Citation; and,

Whereas, Dudley Long served Birmingham-Southern College as its Senior Student Affairs Officer from 1983-2010; and,

Whereas, Dudley Long served the student affairs profession in contemporary college management uninterrupted from 1976; and,

Whereas, Dudley Long remains widely recognized for her professional qualities and personal attributes, regenerating her into an avatar of our disciplines; and,

Whereas, Dudley Long garnered praise symbolized by the creation of the Birmingham-Southern Dudley Long Leadership Award and by her selection for the NASPA Robert Bradshaw Small Colleges Student Advocate Award; and,

Whereas, Dudley Long provided volunteer leadership and service for many associations including NASPA, ASJA, SACSA, ACPA, and AFA during her 34 year tenure; and,

Whereas, Dudley Long claims the love, affection, and admiration of generations of students, student leaders, colleagues, and friends; scores of whom claim her as mentor; therefore,

Be it resolved that the 2010 Leonard Goldberg Citation be bestowed upon Ms. Dudley Long, long-time servant leader at Birmingham-Southern College; and,

Be it resolved that the award will be announced to the Birmingham-Southern College Communications office, and to the Associated Colleges of the South; and,
